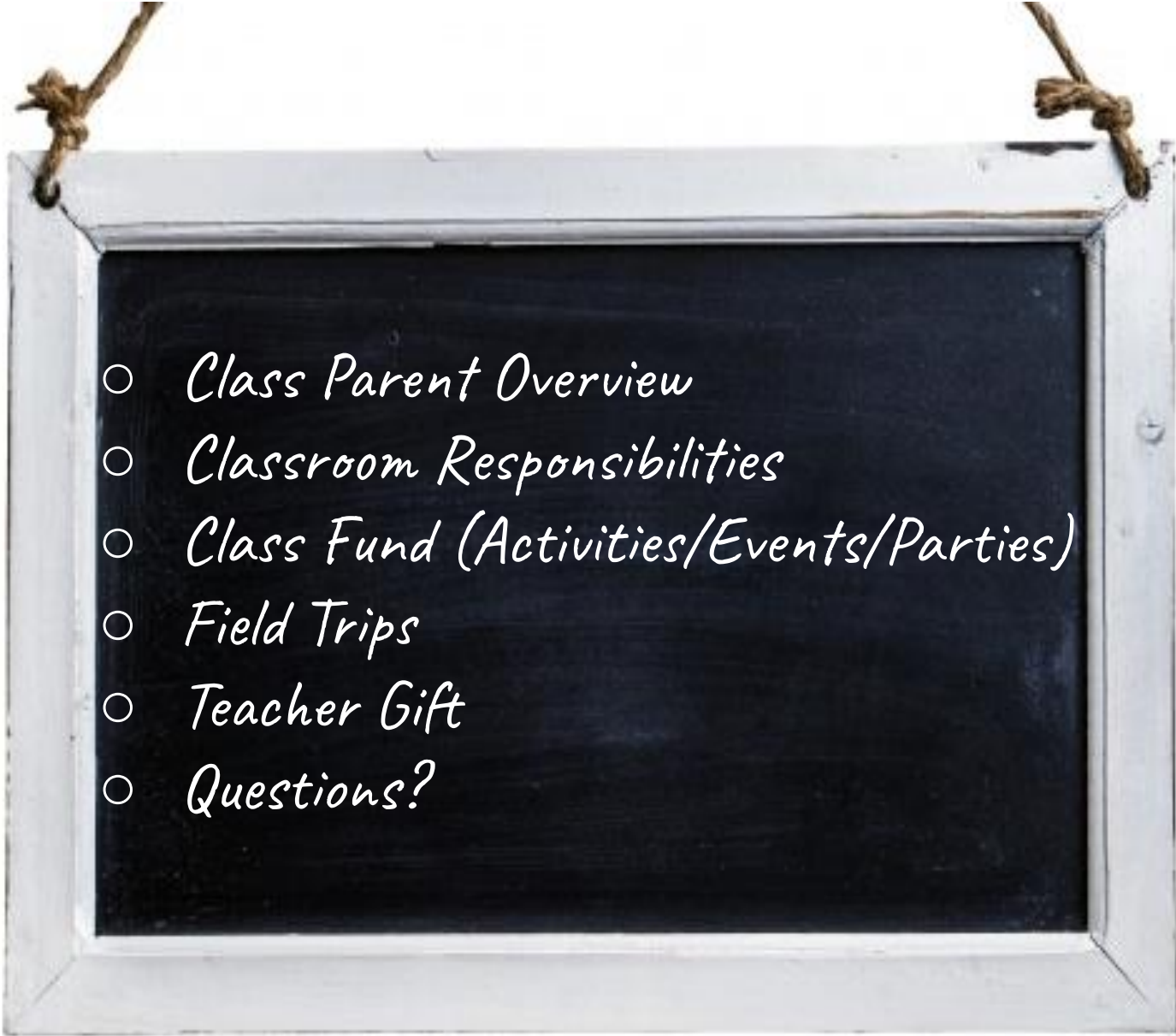

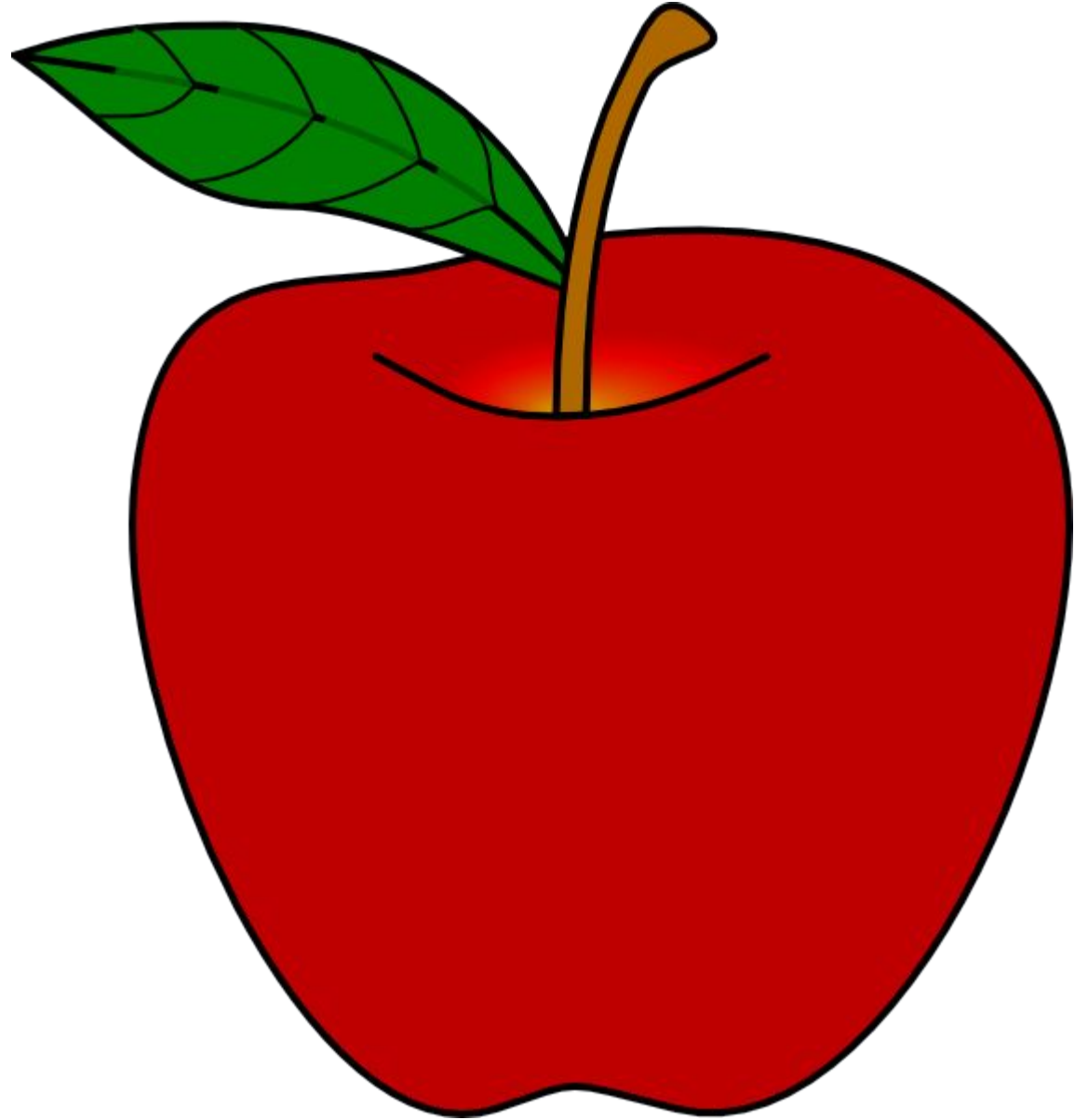

Create a Calendar

Meet with your homeroom teacher to confirm calendar of events for the entire year

Lead Class Parents should connect with grade level co-leads to ensure entire grade is in agreement

Each Class Parent team should meet and discuss the schedule for the year

Create a Budget

One-Time Class Dues of \$30 per student will be collected by October 15th and can be managed by the Lead Class Parent

Estimates per event should be made for the entire school year as soon as possible

Class Funds will never be used for teacher gifts

Create a Plan

Create a school year calendar of all events with fun inclusive activities

Decide what roles each Class Parent will have and determine if volunteers are needed

Lead Class Parents communicate with your teacher and co-leads throughout the year

Teacher Gifts

-One time voluntary collection \$10 per Main Homeroom Teacher*/\$5 per Aide, per Student

Distribute to Teachers/Aides at Year End

OR

Divide Gifts Between Year End and Holiday

- Teacher Gift Fund not to be used for Class Activities

-Communication reminders for Gifting, Teacher Appreciation and milestones

*Upper Grades 4-5-6 only collect from the class for their main homeroom teacher

Class Parent Checklist

- ☐ Collect Class Dues by **Oct. 15th** and plan to record all Class Fund expenses
- ☐ Schedule a meeting with Lead Class Parent and your teacher to discuss calendar
- ☐ Schedule a meeting with your grade level Co-Lead Class Parents to coordinate your calendar of events
- ☐ Meet with your homeroom Class Parents to divide responsibilities and share the annual plans and determine each Class Parent’s role and when volunteers will be needed
- ☐ Prepare your estimated expenses for the entire school year calendar of events
- ☐ Confirm all events and expectations with your teacher and grade level lead teacher. Check in often for any changes!
- ☐ Send “Teacher Gift” email to entire class
- ☐ Send Teacher Appreciation Reminder email or any milestone event reminder email (teacher retirement, teacher celebration, etc.)
- ☐ Send year end thank you email to class families with reminder of class gifting
